Gorlin is known for his inventive use of space, light and natural materials. He holds architecture degrees from Cooper Union and the Yale School of Architecture, and was a Rome Prize Fellow at the American Academy in Rome. He is the author of five books including two on the contemporary American Townhouses and most recently on "Kabbalah in Art and Architecture," which won the National Jewish Book Award in 2013.
